Summary/General Description of Job:

The incumbent is responsible for responding as a team member of fire and emergency crew to save lives; provide first aid; preserve property, the environment, and mission functions; and mitigate hazards during fires, medical emergencies, hazmat incidents, personnel rescues, natural disasters, aircraft incidents, and other emergency events. As an emergency medical technician under the auspices of the installation Chief Medical Officer and EMS Protocols, the incumbent is responsible to apply industry standard and accepted trade practices to perform tasks required to execute and accomplish emergency incident objectives and directions. The incumbent has authority to stop activities that may pose imminent and unforeseen safety hazards or dangers to self, fellow team members, and the public.

Essential Duties and Job Functions:

- Provides medical support for medevacs and marine department as needed.
- Conducts inspections, operations, testing, and first preventive maintenance to ensure readiness and serviceability of all apparatus, equipment, property, and personal protective equipment assigned.
- Applies industry standards and accepted trade practices to perform tasks required to execute and accomplish emergency incident objectives and directions.
- Performs all responsibilities of EMT assigned to the ambulance and engine companies.
- Implements fire codes, standards, regulations, and policies and submittal of mitigation recommendations to fire prevention office.
- Conducts fire risk management surveys and company inspections.
- Provides fire safety training and education to the community to include CPR and EMR.
- Drives ambulance and as needed drive fire apparatus and operates pumps.
- Utilizes power and manual tools and equipment.
- Conducts daily, weekly, monthly and annual facility inspections.
- Conducts fire ground tasks and functions and station duties.
- Works on Meck Island as part of assigned crew performing duties associated with F&ES operations on Meck.
- Conducts facility inspections and prepares pre-fire plans
- Responds to off-duty recalls.
- Receives alarms, calls, and dispatches proper crews as Communications Center Operator.
- Attends all training, instructs classes as required, and participates in the DoD Firefighter Certification Program (FFCP) and physical fitness program.
- Performs other related duties as assigned

Accountable For:

- Meeting the requirements of NFPA 1582 Standard on Comprehensive Occupational Medical Program for Fire Departments.
- Successfully passing physical fitness exam IAW NFPA 1500, drug testing, and background investigation.
- Conducting fire inspections and fire safety programs.
- Effectively communicating both verbally and in writing.
- Working with supervisors in a professional manner.
- Thoroughly understand policies, rules, regulations, practices and procedures of the F&ES organization.

- Graduation from a recognized fire academy resulting in International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC), National Board on Fire Service Professional Qualifications (ProBoard), or Department of Defense (DoD) certification as a Firefighter I & II and Hazmat Awareness and Operations (HAZMAT Operations).
- Possess DoD, ProBoard or IFSAC Driver Operator Pumper, Driver Operator ARFF, Driver Operator MWS certifications
- Aircraft Rescue Firefighter (ARFF) certified by IFSAC, ProBoard (NFPQ), or DOD.
- Possession of Telecommunicator I and II Certificate.
- Possess and maintain a current state or National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician (NREMT) EMT license, and current CPR card.
- Possess a valid state driver's license with acceptable driving record.
- Ability to pass a Federal Background check to obtain and hold a DOD Common Access Card (CAC).
- Possess and maintain current passport.
